



Candidacy requirements include completion of the NALP Curriculum and fulfillment of experience requirements. The candidate has one year to complete the program. To receive the designation, the candidate must have six months of apartment industry experience.

The designation is renewable each year with the submission of three continuing education credits (CEC's) and renewal dues.
